Ná zakladě usnesení Národního shromáždění
nařizuje se:

§ 1.

Ke krytí nákladů na provozování novouzavých prací v Praze povoluje:

- a) na zemní práce a zahrádkní úpravu na pozemcích bývalých iont Strahovských tři pětiny skutečného nákladu, nejvýše 1,200.000 korun;
- b) na stavbu silnice z Holesovice do Bubenče tři pětiny skutečného nákladu, nejvýše však 1,500.000 K;
- c) na dílební práce tři pětina skutečného nákladu, nejvýše však 600.000 K;
- d) na práce kanalizační, a to rušené staré sítě stokové, vystavění výpusť c. 28, stavbu sběrače č. 2 a stoky v ulici Nádražní tři pětiny skutečného nákladu, nejvýše však 791.400 K;
- e) na stavbu malostranského nábreží tři pětiny nákladu, nejvýše však 37.000 K;
- f) na práce vodárenské, a to stavbu přečerpací stanice u Brusky a dvou vodojemů na Andělu tři pětina nákladu, nejvýše však 4.901.600 korun.

§ 2.

Veskeré tyto stavby buděž neodkladně začány veřejným nabídkovým řízením.

§ 3.



Neuční-li tak do označené lhůty (před koncem července 1919), jest Ústřední družstvo ovládnuvalo příslušně je k sobě a jejich jménem vypovědět členstvo k bývalému sídli do jednoho měsíce.







2. map of Great Brno extension in 1919








Schematic tram line map 1937, 1944










original groundfloor plan of the Workers' House, 1930




