SQ3: How did the use of a local referendum affect the design and decisions regarding the urban area development of the cases IJburg and Stadsblokken-Meinerswijk?

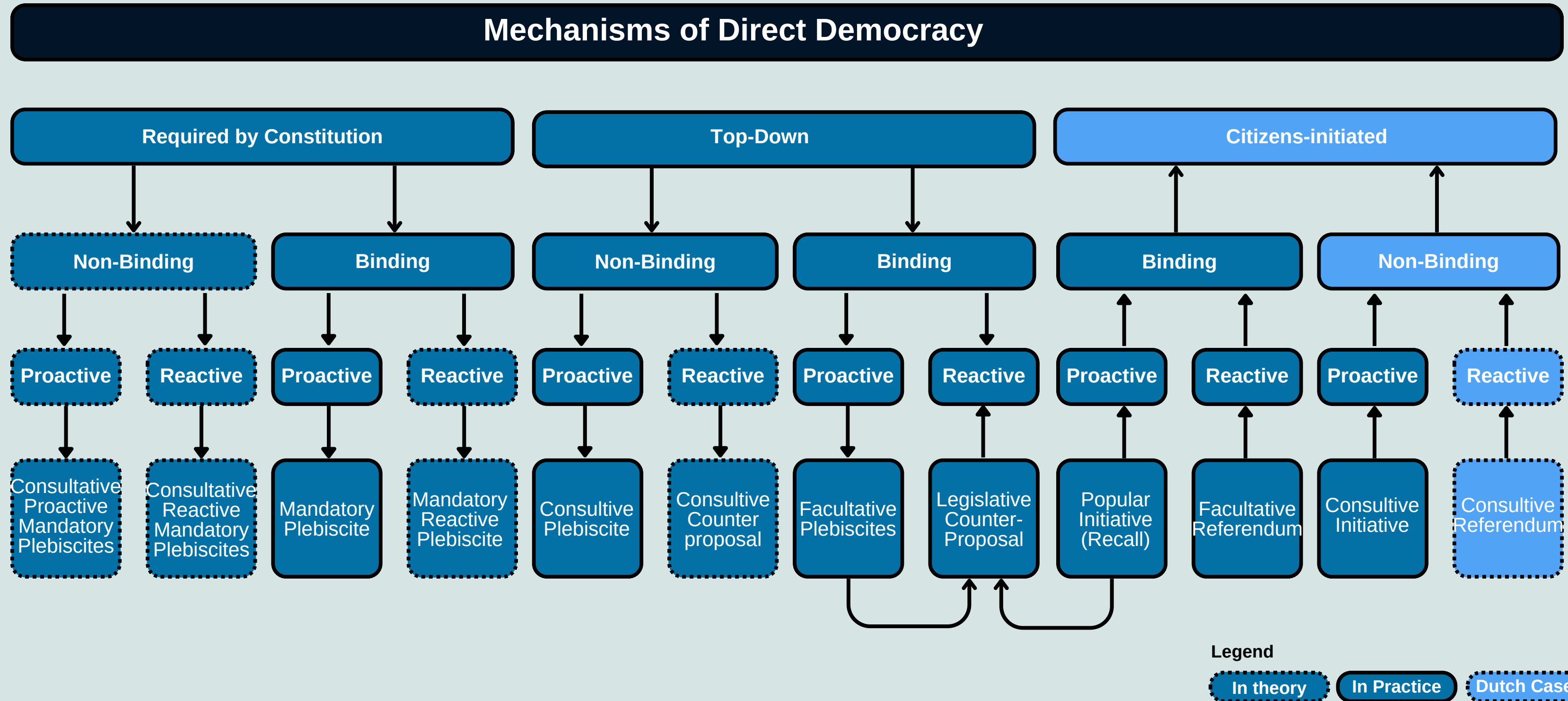
SQ4: How do the actors of the cases IJburg and Stadsblokken-Meinerswijk look back at the instrument of a local referendum for urban area development?

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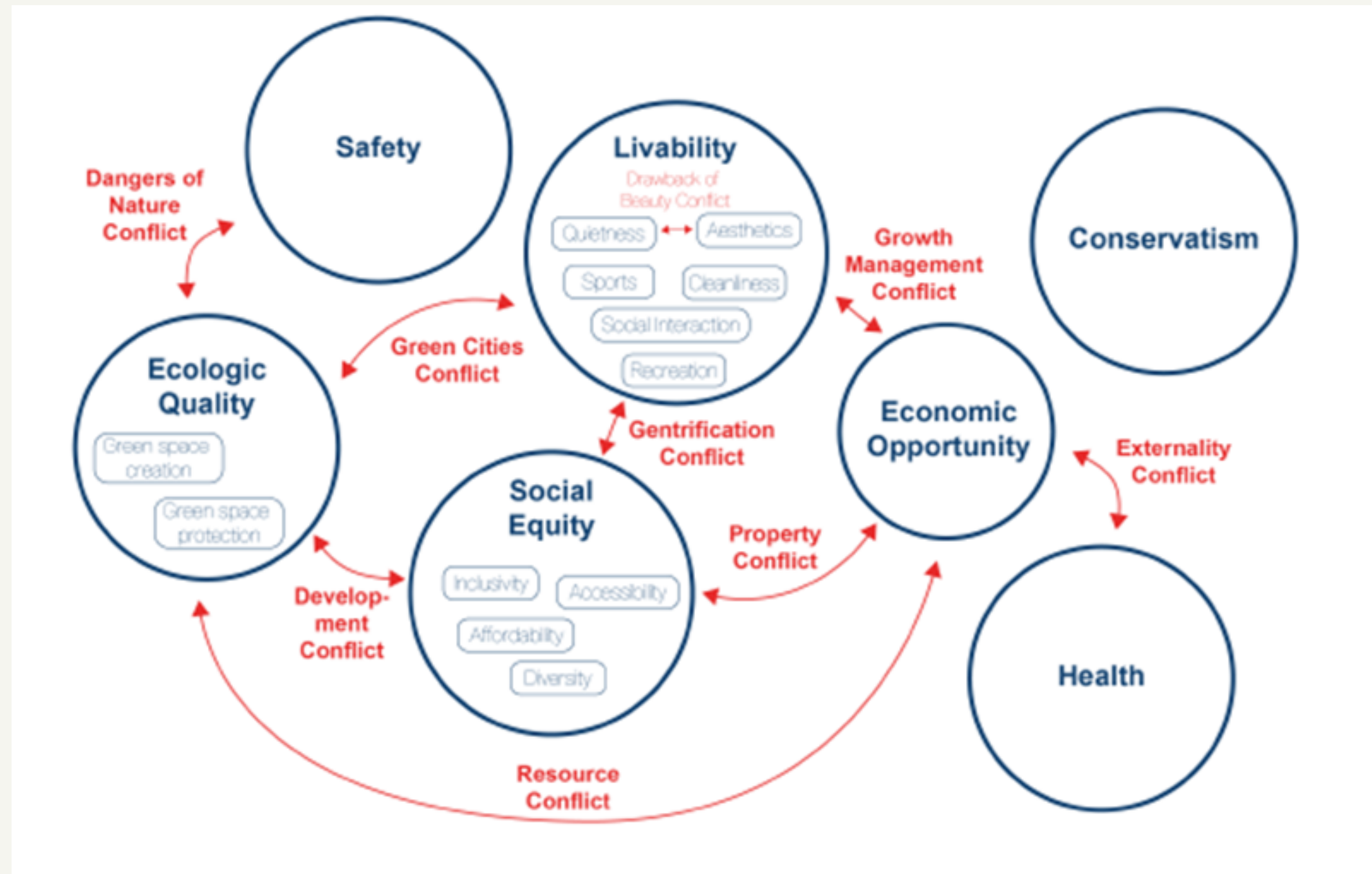

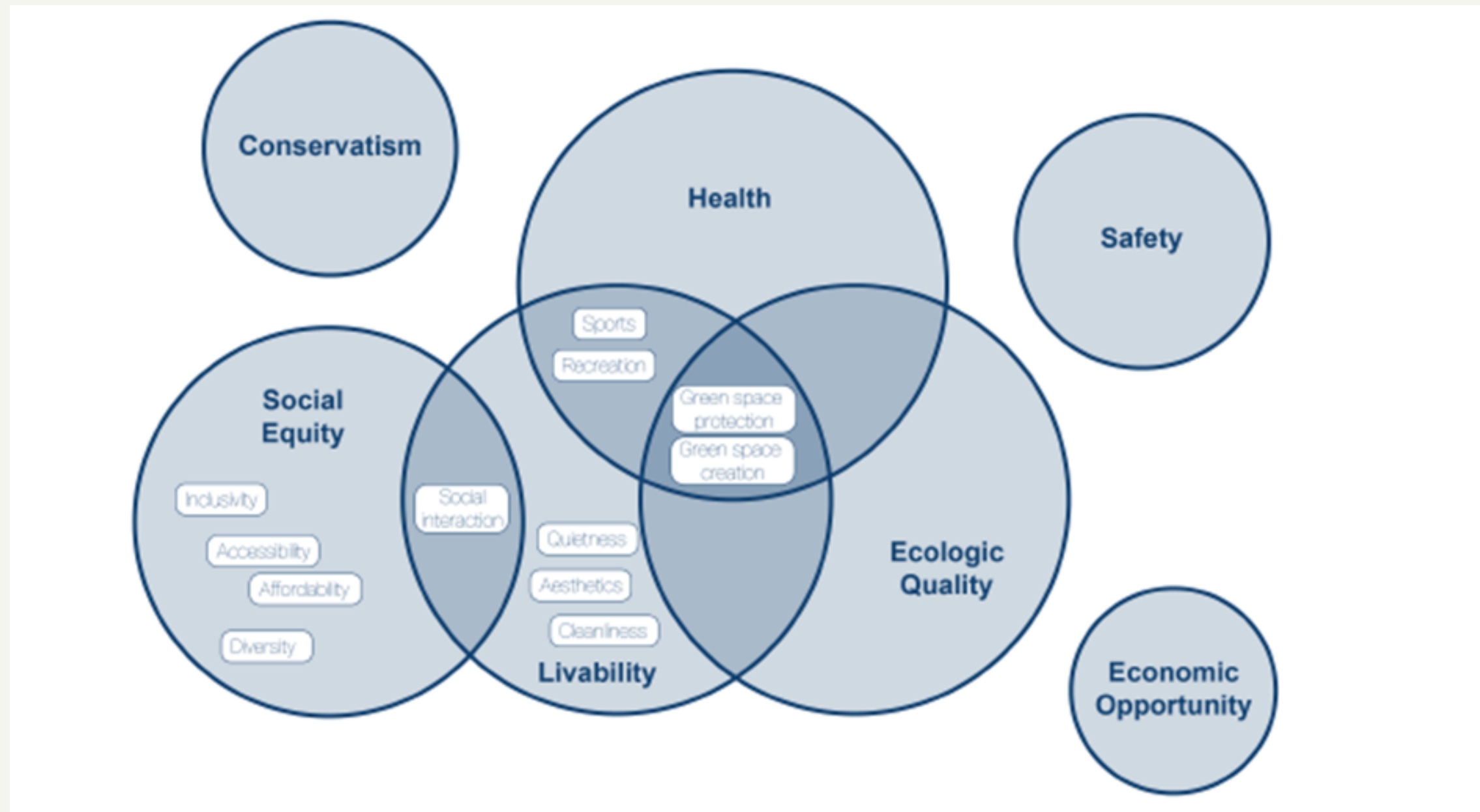

Comparison Case Studies

Development Plan



Amsterdam IJburg

- 18 000 Dwellings
- 220 + 150 ha
- VINEX Policy
- Mainly focussed on housing & businesses



March 1997

Arnhem Stadsblokken-Meinerswijk

- 430 Dwellings
- 289 ha
- Ruimte voor de Rivier Policy
- Focussed on culture, leisure, nature & dwellings



November 2016

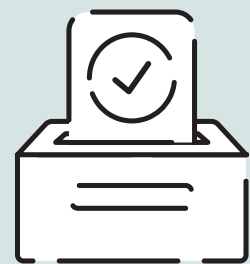

- Nature and housing
- Dwellings can be built somewhere else



Referendum



- corrective, with threshold
- Municipality agreed to respect the outcome
- 41% voted
- 40% Yes, 60% No

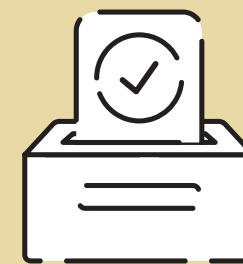
Arnhem Stadsblokken-Meinerswijk

Conflict:

- Nature and housing
- Dwellings can be built somewhere else
- Water safety



Referendum



- corrective, no threshold
- Municipality agreed to respect the outcome
- 24, 1 % voted
- 64,7% Yes, 34,5% No

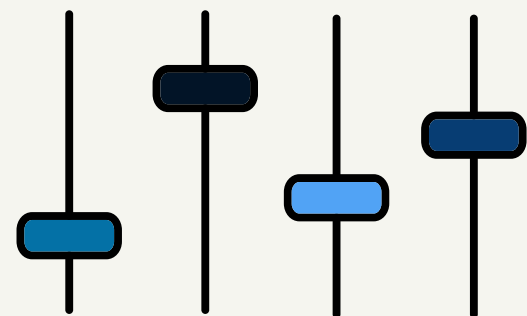
Discussion: Literature



Overlap

- Public Debate
- Awareness
- Unequal Resources
- Scale is difficult
- Municipalities often act on outcome

Discussion: Literature



New Findings

- Society changed
- Difficult for opponents
- More flexibility needed for UAD
- **Need for alternative forms**
 - *Online / digiD*
 - *Informal voting (non-binding)*
 - *Incl. Participation process*
 - *Scale*
 - *Include dialogue*
 - *Citizens forum/Stadsgesprek*
- For Public Value conflict
 - *Nature - Buildings*

 - promises

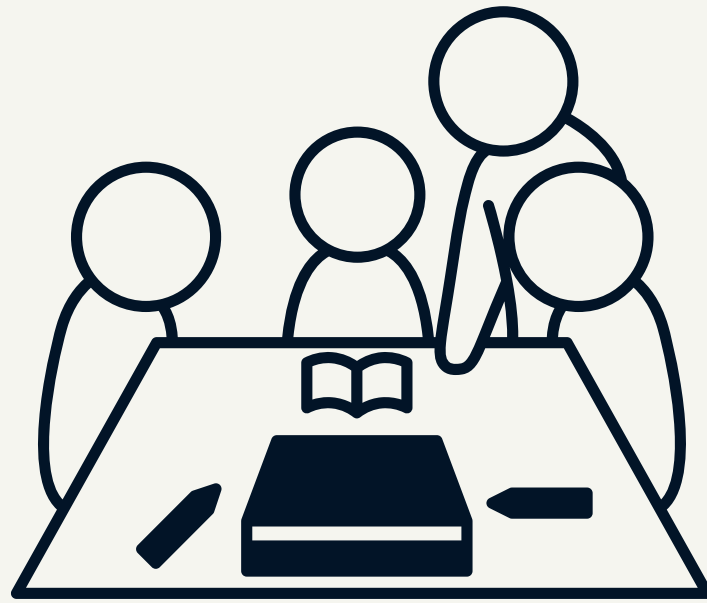

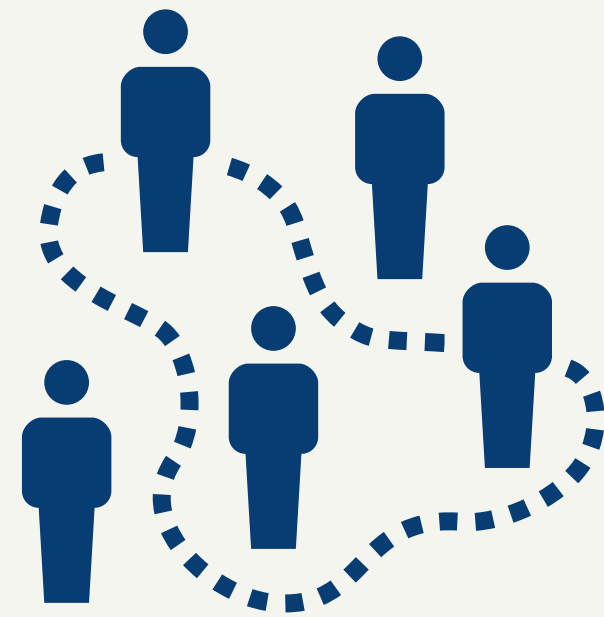
6 Recommendations to improve Local Referendums for UAD



I. Avoid and initiate seldomly



2. Communicate with the opponent: Build in conversation models



3. Communicate to citizens: inform and involve them



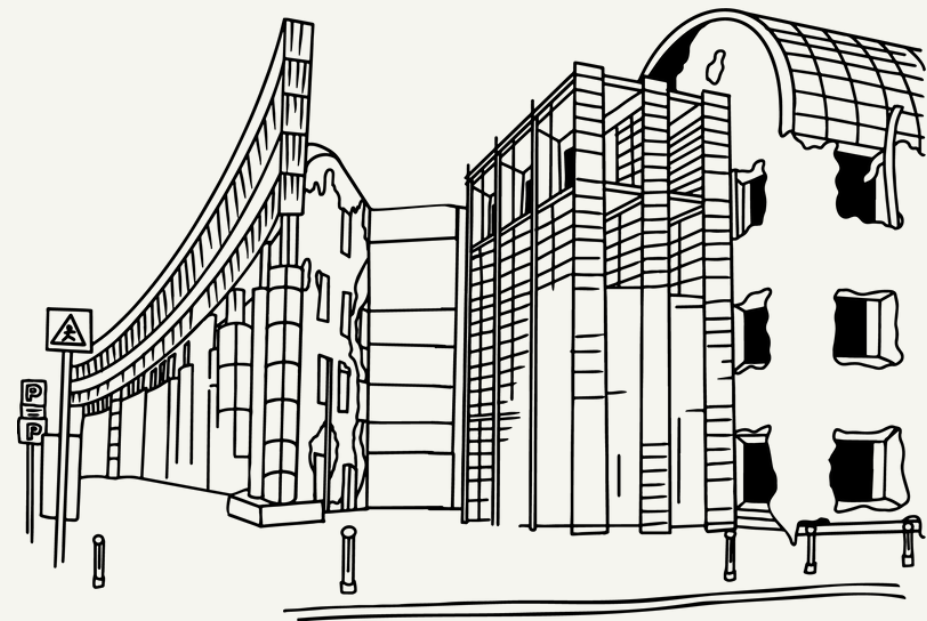
Accessibility



4. Communicate to citizens, together: make it understandable



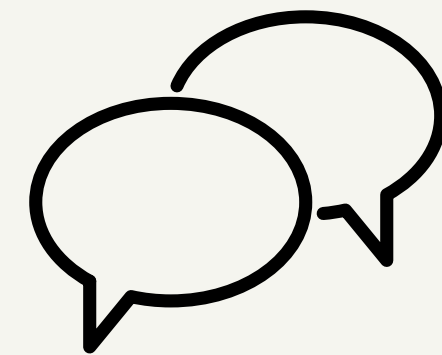

Visualize



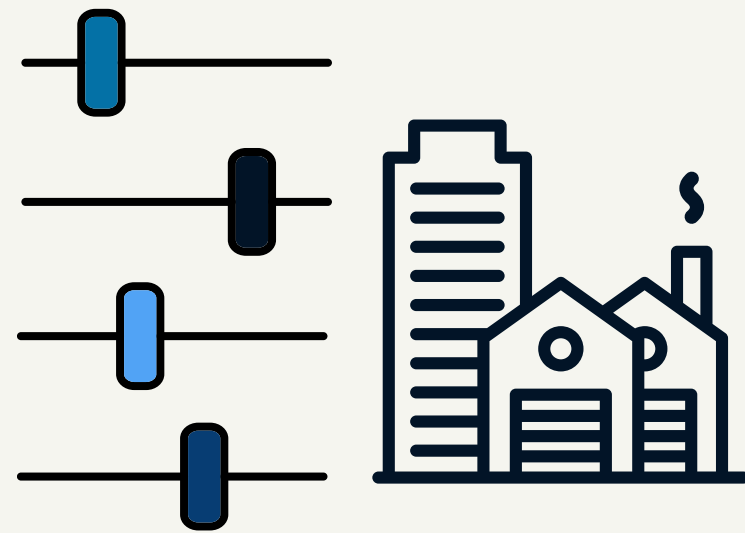
Spread information together
