Aging and double aging population causing an increase of people with dementia




Growing imbalance between people who need care and people who can provide care

- 4. What architectural features contribute to providing care for people with dementia?








The spaces should be domestically scaled, avoid a clinical look, make it more home like in color and lighting




Care perspective

Interesting location for different target groups, Central location in neighbourhood


