


Kinderdijk is distinguished by three "Outstanding Universal Values":


- 1. Its operational water system, which has been in use since the 18th century, a remarkable example of hydraulic engineering.
- 2. The landscape, which features a striking contrast between horizontal canals, dikes, and fields and vertical mill systems.
- 3. The water system, which forms an integrated ensemble, and which represents an example of the evolution of Dutch drainage techniques.














