

Location of the Stockholm City Library.



Room 609 to the west (corridor). Typical door lining.

Building part Material

Linoleum carpet. In the west wing, there is a limestone slab under the windows in some rooms.

North, east and south wings: Small painted wooden moulding with a simple profile at the top. The moulding

continues up into the door and window frames.

West wing: Relatively wide smooth and painted horizontal moulding.

Walls Plastered and painted. Plastered and painted

Outward opening double doors with two smooth infills or glazed infills. Lining of painted wood with a simple profile at the outer edge. New prints in "older" style. There are similar doors between some rooms.

Windows North, east and south wings: Inward facing coupled windows. Nine panes in outer sash divided by small

profile glazing bars. Rel. base plastered and painted alleyway with lining similar to door lining going down to

floor.

West wing: Inward-facing double-hung windows with no centre post. Plastered sills, no window linings, limestone

Other Ventilation grids and vents in walls.

This floor originally included sorting rooms, order and catalogue rooms, workrooms and several rooms for study circles. There was also the city librarian's room, which also served as a boardroom. The rooms mainly retain their original design. The entire floor should originally have had a more colourful colour scheme and the study circle rooms should have had simple decorative painting in the ceilings and painted parapets. The former lunch room (today 624) originally had drapery painting on the walls. Some rooms have subsequently been divided by secondary partitions. Older doors have been kept in place and new doors have been made as copies. The rooms with original or modified layouts are shown on the floor plans that show the age of the walls.

Cultural-historical aspects and details that should not be altered

- Skirting boards (except secondary in rooms 613, 615, 616, 616A, 624)
- Door and window linings
- · Doors to corridor and doors between rooms
- Volume of rooms (no new partitions or suspended ceilings should be built see clarification below regarding exceptions).


Some offices retain their original layout and should not be enlarged or subdivided into smaller rooms. This applies to rooms 624, 605, 605A, 609 and 610. The layout of other office rooms can be changed by removing secondary walls or adding new walls.

Doors

The room does not retain its original function but partly its original design. The entrance area with columns is original, as is the spiral staircase. The room was originally a waiting room, perhaps for those who would meet in study circles.
