Table of Contents

Heritage areas are the tangible legacies of history and culture, valuable to both residents and tourists. Tourists contribute to the preservation of heritage for future generations and support the local economy. However, not all opportunities presented by tourism are exploited. As the number of tourists visiting the Netherlands is expected to increase from 20 million in 2023 to as many as 29 million in 2030 (Nederlands Bureau voor Tourisme & Congressen (NBTC), 2019; Strijland, 2023), it is crucial to make the most of these opportunities. Nevertheless, tourists also bring challenges that can be particularly harmful to both heritage areas and their local communities (NBTC, 2019).

One of the challenges of tourism is the increasing pressure on infrastructure in and around heritage areas. Increasing numbers of tourists put pressure on roads, car parks, public transport and other facilities. This challenge affects accessibility not only for tourists, but also for local residents who share the same road network (United Nations World Tourism Organization (UNWTO), 2019; Van Der Borg et al., 2022). In addition, tourism can lead to a reduction in the quality of life for local residents. The frequent arrival of visitors can disrupt residents' daily lives and change their living environment. This impact can extend not only to the physical environment, but also to the cultural and social dynamics of the area. The culture of the community is put under pressure and the relationship between residents and tourists is negatively affected (De Groot, 2022; International Council of Monuments and Sites (ICOMOS), 2022). Another potential challenge for the tourism industry is the decline in the quality of the tourist experience. Increasing numbers of tourists can lead to overcrowding of certain activities, preventing tourists from participating in all activities and ultimately reducing the quality of their visit. This can lead to a decrease in the

number of high quality tourists and an increase in the attraction of tourists who are not bothered by crowds. Tourists from the latter group may only get a superficial view of the destination, losing the essence of the heritage (UNWTO, 2019; Van Der Borg et al., 2022).

In order to ensure that tourism has a positive socio-economic impact, it is important to address the challenges that arise from the increased use of public space. Redesigning public spaces in heritage areas can be crucial to better accommodate the increasing flow of tourists while also improving the quality of life for residents (NBTC, 2019). The challenges of public spaces in heritage locations require a holistic approach that combines physical and social perspectives. Furthermore, when planning development, it is important to consider the interests of both tourists and residents.

This research aims to investigate public spaces in heritage areas and make recommendations for their development while respecting the heritage, tourists, and residents. This leads to the main research question: 'What are the development options for public spaces in heritage locations that consider the needs of the heritage, tourists, and residents?' The sub-questions will lead to the answer to the main research question. 'What are the characteristics and conditions of public spaces at heritage locations?', 'How have these spaces developed and adapted over time?' and 'How are they used and experienced by both locals and tourists?'

To address the research questions, this study focuses on two Dutch villages, Kinderdijk and Zaanse Schans. These villages share common characteristics, such as their heritage status, public accessibility, direct presence of residents, challenges caused by tourism, and interventions

they have undergone. The destinations have been independently researched and compared, enabling broader recommendations to be made for development options in heritage areas. The research is valuable due to its potential for application in various contexts, ranging from local to international levels. Additionally, the integration of different research methods, application of existing theories, and focus on practical aspects make it a comprehensive insight into the issues related to tourism in heritage areas.

2. Methodology

This research used an integrated methodology that combined different approaches to understand the challenges within the public spaces of heritage areas, which can ultimately lead to the identification of development opportunities.

To achieve this, a literature review was conducted to identify the most important concepts related to heritage areas under high tourist pressure. In addition, the research focused on the theories and methodologies of Jan Gehl, a renowned urban planner and architect, known for his ability to create valuable, livable, and people-oriented public spaces. A comparative case study was then carried out, analyzing the public spaces of two heritage areas Kinderdijk and Zaanse Schans through document analysis. This study also highlights the interventions that the cases have undergone in recent years.

In order to gain insight into the use, quality and experience of these spaces, fieldwork was carried out in the public spaces using Gehl's theories and methods. Gehl's tools were used to analyze the basic conditions, demonstrate the impact of interventions on space usage, and compare the two heritage sites (Gehl, 2010; Gehl & Svarre, 2013). However, the tools used during the fieldwork were adaptations of Gehl's instruments to fit the research framework.

The fieldwork began with a quantitative tool, the People Moving Count, to understand activity and mobility patterns in public spaces. The Stationary Activity was then mapped to determine whether the public spaces were mainly used for movement or for staying. Finally, Intercept Surveys were conducted among users of public spaces who gave permission. This qualitative instrument provided information about users' perceptions and experiences and offered deeper insights into

what the other instruments revealed (Bernard van Leer Foundation et al., 2018; Gehl Institute, 2016; Gehl Studio, 2015).

The access to the Zaanse Schans for all visitors is via a footbridge, which is one of the defining elements of the site. Once visitors cross the bridge, they leave behind the arrival of the various transport flows and reach the pedestrian area.

3. Results

The research is based on two heritage areas. On the one hand, on Kinderdijk, a UNESCO World Heritage site since 1997, which symbolizes the centuries-long battle against water. And on the other hand, on the Zaanse Schans, a cultural-historical heritage site that symbolizes the industrial boom of the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries. Kinderdijk and the Zaanse Schans are both heritage areas with distinct features. Kinderdijk's water system protects the land from flooding, while the Zaanse Schans is a reconstructed Zaan village made up of various monuments from the area. Despite their differences in narrative, the two areas share some similarities. Both Kinderdijk and Zaanse Schans are publicly accessible and appear to be popular tourist destinations, while the areas are at the same time closely connected to local residents (Stichting de Zaanse Schans et al., 2019; UNESCO World Heritage Centre, n.d.; ZKA Strategy & SVP, 2019).

Analysis and Interventions

Appendices 7.1. and 7.2. provide overviews of the functions and their locations in Kinderdijk and Zaanse Schans. These overviews can aid in understanding the analysis described. Appendices 7.3. and 7.4. offer a better understanding of the completed interventions by providing an overview of the interventions, including the relevant years and locations in Kinderdijk and Zaanse Schans.

Regarding infrastructure, there are several transportation options available to reach Zaanse Schans, including tour buses, public transport buses, cars, and bicycles (Stichting de Zaanse Schans et al., 2019). These options also apply to Kinderdijk, although these are not the only choices. Kinderdijk appears to be accessible not only by land but also by water, with additional transportation options such as water buses and river cruises. Kinderdijk has recently undergone an intervention that includes the construction of an additional jetty for cruise ships. An entry and exit zone for tour buses has also been built, and

a path now leads from this zone to the heritage location (Stichting Werelderfgoed Kinderdijk, 2022; Land iD, 2022; Stichting Werelderfgoed Kinderdijk, 2019-2023; ZKA Strategy & SVP, 2019).

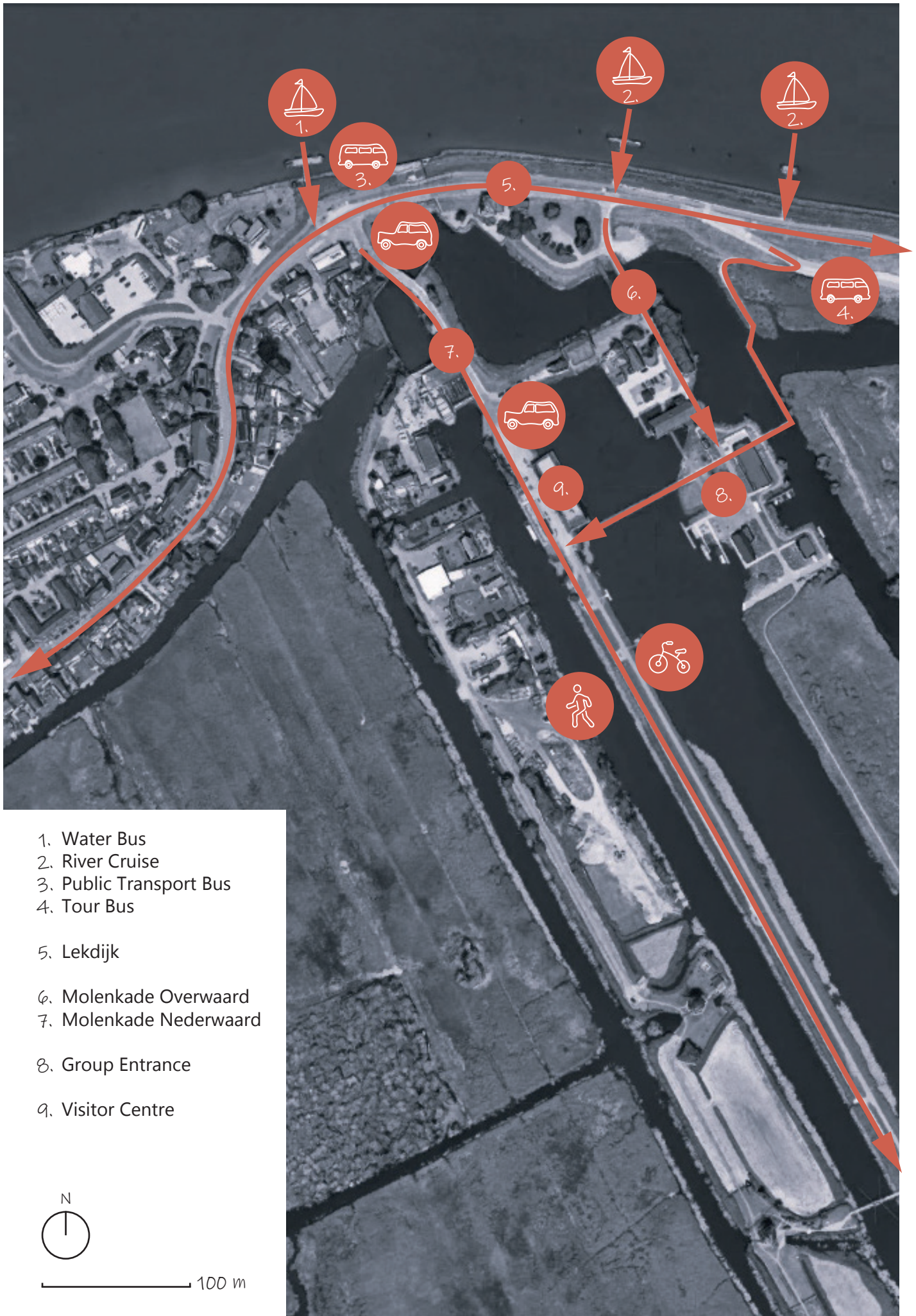
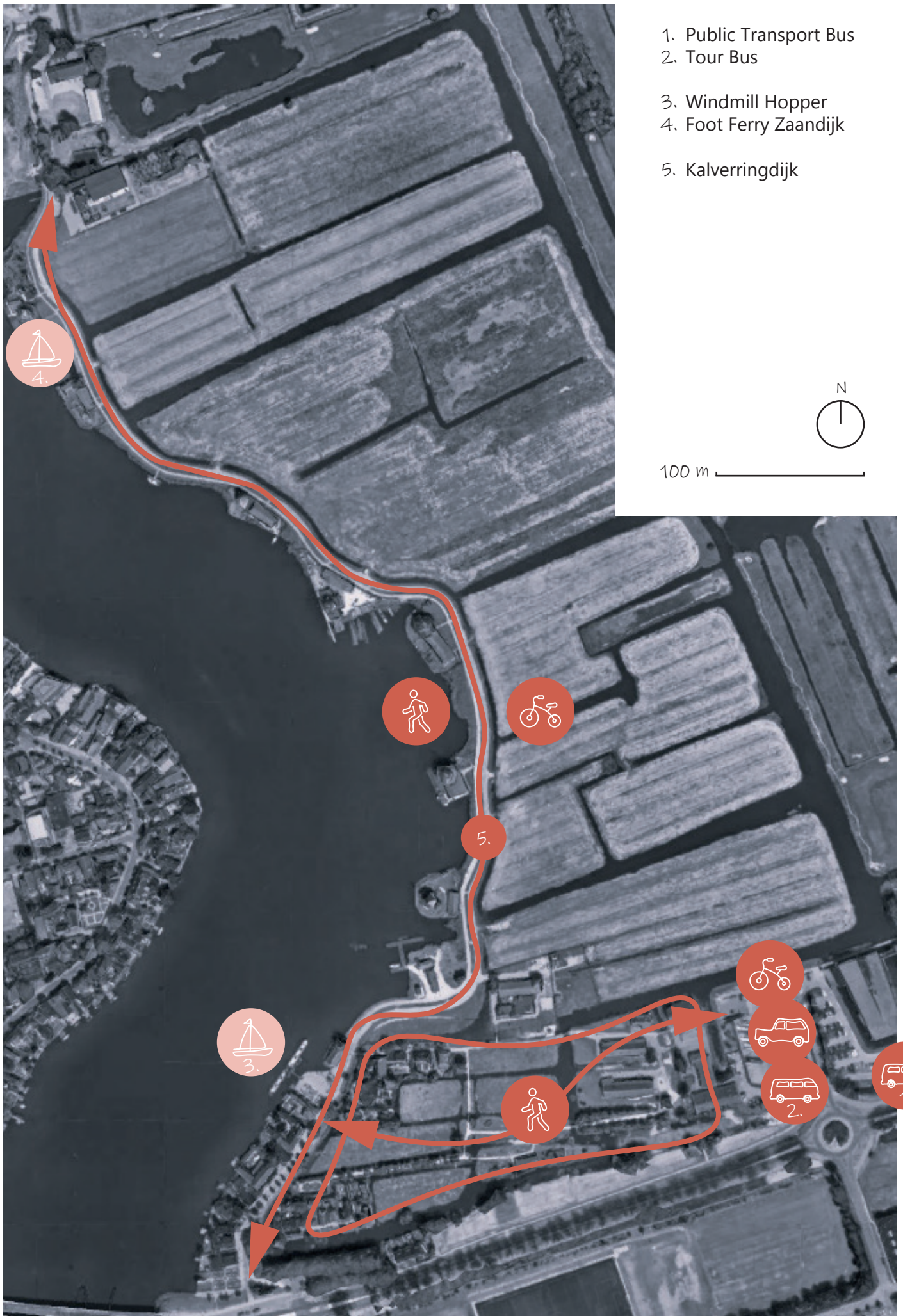


Figure 6: Infrastructure, Kinderdijk (Google Maps-Map of Kinderdijk, n.d.)

Figures 6 and 7 provide an overview of the arrival points per mode of transport in Kinderdijk and Zaanse Schans. It is noteworthy that the arrival location in Kinderdijk varies depending on the visitor's choice of transportation, whereas at Zaanse Schans, the visitor arrives at the same location regardless of the mode of mobility (see Figure 3). Additionally, Figure 7 illustrates that the arrival area of Zaanse Schans leads into a pedestrian area. The pedestrian area ends at Kalverringdijk, which is now shared by pedestrians and cyclists (see Figure 4). Previously, cars were also allowed on the dike, but for safety reasons, it has been closed to car traffic. To compensate for the loss of cars, an additional water connection is constructed along the dike, expanding the water mobility network (Stichting de Zaanse Schans, 2018, 2020, 2021, 2023; Stichting de Zaanse Schans et al., 2019). So, in Kinderdijk, there are several arrival points. However, regardless of the mode of transportation, the first encounter with Kinderdijk is the Lekdijk (see figure 8). This dike is crossed by a busy road to reach either Molenkade Overwaard (see figure 9) or Molenkade Nederwaard (see figure 10). Both mill quays can be accessed by car up to a certain point. After that, cars must be parked, and pedestrians and cyclists can continue their journey (see figure 11). After the visitor centre, both mobility flows even have their own separate paths (see figure 5). (Land iD, 2022; ZKA Strategy & SVP, 2019).

For both Kinderdijk and Zaanse Schans, the windmills are a major attraction for tourists from all over the world. But, in Kinderdijk, the

pumping stations, locks, dikes, polders and reservoirs also play an important role in the water management system. Additionally, the Nederwaard and Overwaard water board houses are part of the story, as is the Pot terrain, where one of the three remaining Pot barns still stands. Steel mill rods were invented and produced on the Pot site, which was an innovation compared to the original wooden rods. However, it is unclear to visitors of Kinderdijk to what extent all the mentioned elements together form the story. The Pot terrain, in particular, may not attract the attention it deserves as it is partly filled with parking spaces. A logical choice, given the parking space shortage that Kinderdijk has been struggling with for years. Yet, the parking lot is only accessible to employees, while visitors and local residents also face the parking problem (Land iD, 2022; Stichting Werelderfgoed Kinderdijk, 2019-2023; ZKA Strategy & SVP, 2019).

Several interventions have already been implemented to enhance the story of Kinderdijk. For instance, an entrance zone has been established on Molenkade Overwaard, featuring an entrance building and a replica of Hulpgemeal de Fabriek. A film is shown here to provide an understanding of the story of Kinderdijk. Molenkade Nederwaard has also been transformed with the addition of the visitor center. In addition, the two quays are connected by a bridge (Land iD, 2022; Stichting Werelderfgoed Kinderdijk, 2019-2023; ZKA Strategy & SVP, 2019).

In addition to the windmills, the Zaanse village is filled with various buildings that form an ensemble. The ensemble continues to expand with missing elements that are on the list of defining elements. This list was drawn up in 1968 by Jaap Schipper, the founder of the

Zaanse Schans. In addition to craft workshops, where craftsmen produce various goods to this day, the list also includes admonitions, shops, air houses, drawbridges and workers' houses. To further enhance the cultural offerings that contribute to the story of the Zaan region and its timber construction, the ensemble has also been expanded with the Mill Museum. The museum was relocated from Koog aan de Zaan to the end of the Zaanse Schans (Stichting de Zaanse Schans, 2018, 2020, 2021, 2023; Stichting de Zaanse Schans, 2024; Stichting de Zaanse Schans et al., 2019).

Fieldwork

To implement the People Moving Count (see the results in Appendix 7.7.) and Stationary Activity Mapping (see the results in Appendix 7.8.), a research area was defined. Before the site visit, a similar area was demarcated for both Kinderdijk and Zaanse Schans, specifically the arrival area (see the demarcated areas in Appendices 7.5. and 7.6.). The same research area was used to conduct the Intercept Survey tool. However, during the fieldwork, it became clear that all interviewees in both arrival areas were tourists, whereas it was considered important within the study to take into account the residents as well. Therefore, the research area was expanded in both cases, which led to the discovery of non-tourist respondents. Please refer to Appendices 7.9. and 7.10. for the collection points of the intercept surveys per respondent in Kinderdijk and Zaanse Schans, and to Appendix 7.11. for the results of the intercept surveys. This appendix concludes with graphs comparing the answers of the respondents from Kinderdijk and Zaanse Schans per question.

The fieldwork results confirm that the arrival area of Zaanse Schans is a pedestrian zone, while the arrival area of Kinderdijk is accessible by various means of transport. The results also indicate that both individual visitors and groups use the arrival area of Zaanse Schans, in contrast to the Kinderdijk arrival area. The demarcated area on Molenkade Nederwaard appears to be exclusively used by individual visitors, meanwhile, groups enter through the group entrance located on Molenkade Overwaard.

Furthermore, the demarcated area of Zaanse Schans seems to be more of a place to stay compared to the area of Kinderdijk, based on the length of time spent there. This can be attributed to visitors often keeping a flow path clear and not using it as a place to stay, as well as the presence or absence of elements that encourage people to stop. The Kinderdijk area has been designed as a flow route without any elements that invite visitors to stay, whereas the Zaanse Schans area has a path that functions as a flow route with a connecting square that offers stimulating elements to stay (see figure 12). Although the added bridge in Kinderdijk was initially intended as a flow route, it has become a short-term place to stay. The bridge was added to encourage crossing from one quay to the other, but it is used as a viewpoint instead (see figure 13). While groups will make the crossing to visit one of the two mill museums, individual visitors often remain on Molenkade Nederwaard. Another notable difference between the arrival areas of the two locations is the prevalence of the cultural category among Kinderdijk users, while it is almost non-existent among Zaanse Schans users. The participants were assigned to this category when they were actively observing the buildings and their surroundings.

After expanding the study area, it was found that both Kinderdijk and Zaanse Schans are popular destinations for visitors from around the world, as well as locals. The contrast between the residents of Kinderdijk and Zaanse Schans is noticeable, with the latter only using the area as a transit point. Despite the absence of cars, the Kalverringdijk remains problematic. Local respondents have expressed concerns about the heavy traffic on the dike caused by the large number of tourists. The tourists are not aware that they should give priority to passing cyclists, resulting in dangerous situations. Additionally, excessive tourism has led to locals avoiding the

area. Respondents from Kinderdijk also reported avoiding the tourist area. The main difference between Zaanse Schans and Kinderdijk is that the former has been completely taken over by tourists, while the latter's tourist epicenter does not cover the entire area. Based on the results, the tourist hub extends to Museummolen Nederwaard. Beyond this point, tourist activity decreases significantly, with few visitors venturing to Museummolen Blokweer or beyond. In contrast to the residents interviewed at Zaanse Schans, local respondents from Kinderdijk seem to enjoy recreation in the less crowded areas. In fact, recreationists from Kinderdijk visit the area regularly.

Finally, it is noteworthy that only a small number of tourists surveyed in Kinderdijk intended to stay for more than an hour. Conversely, at Zaanse Schans, all tourists agreed that the village is worth a longer visit, lasting at least an hour. Although Kinderdijk is often viewed as a brief stopover, local employees disagree. Both millers expressed their dissatisfaction with tourists who believe that the area is solely about the mills and taking photographs. The mills will always have their appeal, but the millers suggest that there is a need to raise awareness of the history behind them.

Although infrastructure interventions have already been carried out in Kinderdijk and Zaanse Schans in recent years, there is still room for improvement in this area. For instance, visitors arriving in Kinderdijk are immediately confronted with the dike road, regardless of their means of transport used to reach the area. This dike road poses a challenge for access to the heritage area due to the heavy flow of traffic, which forms a hard boundary. Intersecting the flow of traffic with slow-moving visitors not only creates unsafe situations but also causes congestion for cars. The flow of cars is constantly interrupted and even at different points. A similar approach to that of Zaanse Schans, where visitors immediately enter a pedestrian area upon arrival, could enhance the public space of Kinderdijk.

In addition it could help to reduce the dominance of the car within the Kinderdijk heritage area. Parking could be moved to the edge of the area, similar to the approach in Zaanse Schans where cars were removed from the heritage area. However, it is important to consider the impact this may have on local residents.

The separate mobility flows of cyclists and pedestrians on Molenkade Nederwaard in Kinderdijk and on the Kalverringdijk on the Zaanse Schans are conducive to mobility within both heritage areas. However, conflicting mobility flows still occur in both areas, with Kinderdijk experiencing this phenomenon in several places and Zaanse Schans only encountering it where pedestrians have to cross the bicycle flow to continue their way across the Kalverringdijk. To enhance the public spaces of Kinderdijk and Zaanse Schans, it is recommended to separate mobility flows and avoid intersections between them.

Regarding space usage, it is noteworthy that

areas frequented by tourists are often avoided by locals. This phenomenon is observed throughout the entire Zaanse Schans area, where locals tend to use public spaces for transit rather than leisure. Conversely, at Kinderdijk, there appears to be a central area for tourists that is avoided by locals, while the surrounding areas are used by the local population for recreational purposes. A recommendation is to separate tourists and locals when it comes to the local quality of life in heritage areas, rather than trying to mix the two.

When it comes to length of stay, the results show a significant difference in the respondents' perception of the suitability of the heritage areas for long or short stays. The Zaanse Schans is considered a destination for longer stays, while Kinderdijk is seen as more suitable for shorter stays. To attract high-quality tourists, it is crucial to increase the length of stay in Kinderdijk. Providing information can be a useful tool, but it is also important to offer appropriate accommodations. For instance, consider the entrance square of Zaanse Schans, where the cultural aspect was not fully utilised. This was because visitors initially focused on acclimatising and preparing for their visit, rather than on the buildings or surroundings. While the entrance area offers a first glimpse, the full picture only unfolds as visitors explore further, creating a sense of anticipation and discovery. Kinderdijk lacks clear signage and information, as tourists are often distracted by the view upon arrival, leading to a tunnel vision towards the mills. Improved access facilities could potentially solve this problem.

Reflection

The fieldwork was conducted three times a day while respecting the integrity of the heritage sites and adhering to ethical guidelines. It provided extensive data, including insights based on

assumptions. For instance, respondents' answers appeared to be influenced by the location of the interviews. Those interviewed on the dike in the Zaanse Schans reacted more negatively than those in the pedestrian area. In Kinderdijk, participants questioned near the entrance area responded more negatively than those questioned in the rear area. However, this study cannot definitively state a relationship due to the small number of participants. The limited sample size was due to the time-intensive nature of surveying people. The study's value could increase with additional intercept surveys. In addition, the value of the research can be increased by taking into account the seasonal variability of tourism. The study's findings were obtained during the low season, so additional research during the high season could yield varying results.

5. From Research to Design

The aim of this research was to identify development opportunities within the public spaces of heritage areas with high tourist pressure and to explore methods to implement improvements. The resulting ambition of this research is to discover how the public space of the Kinderdijk heritage area can be improved using the research results.

A specific design intervention within the public space of the Kinderdijk heritage area could be to create a central arrival point accessible to all visitors, regardless of their mode of transportation. The Pot terrain outside the dike could be a suitable location for this arrival area, as it offers space for boats to dock, buses to arrive, and car parking. By moving car parking to the Pot site, cars are immediately removed from the heritage area. Furthermore, commencing all visits from a single point has the added benefit of reducing the number of intersections with the dike road to just one. Additionally, it may even be possible to eliminate this intersection by directing pedestrian traffic under the road, through the dike, and into the heritage area. In addition, it is recommended that the first part of the heritage area becomes a pedestrian zone. The pedestrian zone could be extended to the point where the mobility flows of cyclists and pedestrians are separated. Together, these design interventions would avoid any conflicting intersections and ensure a safer and more efficient flow of traffic.

The Pot terrain could not only improve mobility within Kinderdijk, but also enhance the visitor experience of tourists. The site could accommodate facilities that could contribute to the preparation for the visit to Kinderdijk. Consider the more obvious facilities such as a ticket desk, locker room and toilets, but a cinema would also not be out of place at this location. The film, which is currently shown at

Hulpgemaal de Fabriek, could be played here, so that not only groups, but also individual visitors could benefit from this source of information. In addition, exhibition spaces could be added to further clarify the story behind Kinderdijk before the actual visit begins.

Both tourists and residents will benefit from the infrastructure design interventions. However, the design interventions for accommodating facilities appear to primarily benefit tourists. Therefore, a final design proposal could be to include facilities for both tourists and local residents in the entrance area. It is therefore important that the facilities are strictly separated from each other, so that the tourists do not take over the functions of the residents.
